- IO3 C-STEP 3 'Demographic change' didactical framework, units and training resources
- IO4 Media Centre and learning environment Complementary Content, Material and Resources
- IO5 Web Portal for participants, counsellors and guidance practitioners and lecturers

By focusing on the development of training programmes to address urgent issues and current key challenges in labour market and counselling Academia+ supports provision of better services and guidance on skills and qualifications.

The first topics for the envisaged three Counsellors' Study and Training Exchange Programmes (STEP) were chosen according to their importance for the current labour market: Counselling migrants and refugees, Future jobs and Demographic change.
